 No student will be permitted to try out or participate on an interscholastic team until he/she has the school triplicate form signed and returned to the nurse and also passes a physical examination given by the district physician. 	

- 2. All athletes shall follow Section XI Code of Conduct and respect coaches, facilities, officials and opponents.
- 3. Athletes found to have broken training rules or have been involved with actions that have a negative effect on the individual or team will be suspended from the team and referred to the Building Principal and Athletic Director.
- 4. Athletes are required to attend practices daily. Athletes with an unexcused absence on contest day, or the day before a contest will not participate in the contest. The coach can suspend athletes missing more than one contest. If an extenuating circumstance exists, a note from parent/ guardian must be presented to the coach prior to practice/contest for review/approval (in conjunction with A.D./Principal)
- 5. All athletes are expected to ride a late bus home if one is being offered or be picked up by a parent/guardian immediately following practice/games. Excessive late pickups will be referred by the Coach to the Athletic Director's office for review.
- 6. Extenuating circumstances regarding someone picking up your student athlete beside the parent/guardian on record must be presented to coach, in writing, at least 24 hours prior to event and signed by parent/guardian, building principal, and the Athletic Director.
- 7. Athletes are responsible for all uniforms and equipment issued to them. Items that are not returned will be charged back to the family of the student. Report cards/diplomas may not be issued until restitution is made.
- 8. Student athletes must be in attendance no later than the beginning of period 4 in order to be eligible to participate in a practice, scrimmage or contest on that day. Extenuating circumstances must be presented to the coach and Athletic Director in writing and signed by parent/guardian.
- 9. All athletes will adhere to Riverhead's Co-Curricular Eligibility criteria. In summary, one failure = warning, two failures = probation, three failures = ineligible for current marking period.
